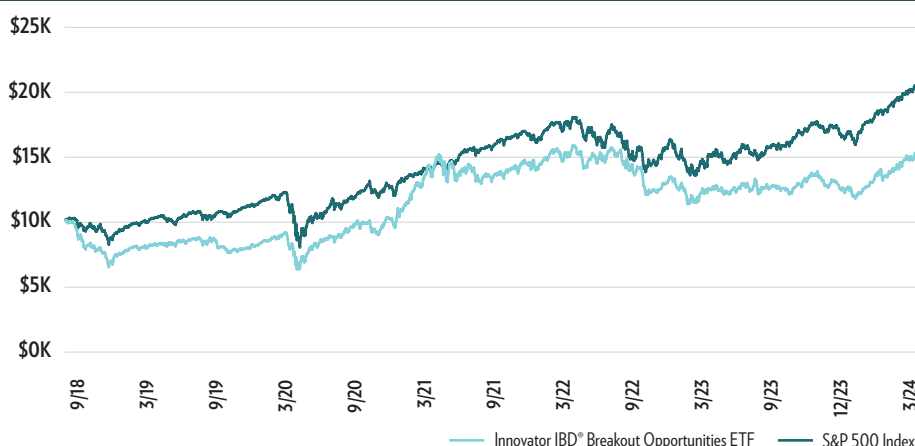

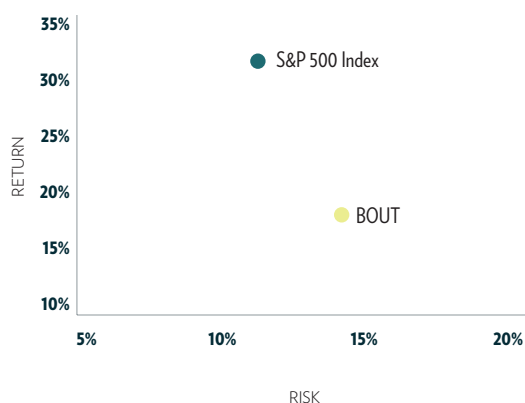

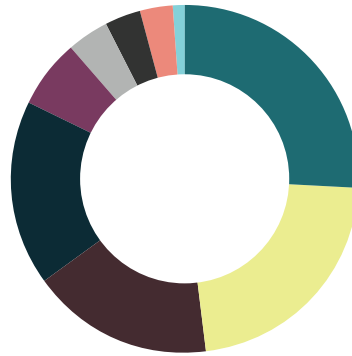

Return/Risk is the relationship between the amount of return gained on an investment and the amount of risk undertaken in that investment.
